

2020 GOALS

1. Empower and equip existing 21 church network committees and 11,120 volunteers with skills and tools needed to ensure program quality for all our beneficiaries.
2. Document impact and successful phase out of 10 sectors from three CEZs.
3. Engage five new church networks within Karongi and Ngoma to scale our CEZ efforts.
4. Initiate Families for Life program in Musanze and Ngoma CEZs.
5. Equip and engage national denominations to embrace the principles of integral mission

SIGNIFICANT STATS AND HIGHLIGHTS

1. World Relief Rwanda (WRR) conducted two national-level trainings last year using the Transformation Tree Curriculum (TTC) reaching 52 church leaders from 12 denominations.
2. WRR organized and led two vision trips for Rwanda senior church leaders to Bugesera and Ngoma CEZs.
3. WRR conducted over 25 program quality assessments in the last year.
4. In the last year, WRR piloted new initiatives in Women's Empowerment, a joint Agriculture & Savings study, Digital Savings Groups and Home-Based Early Childhood Development.



Outreach Group Initiative



For 14 years, Jean Claude's alcohol addiction brought misery to his family. In fear of physical abuse from him, Jean Claude's wife Julienne would often take the children and run away from home for extended periods of time. The addiction also left them with little income to survive. Since the OGI church volunteer started regularly visiting their home with lessons, Jean Claude is a changed man and their lives have drastically improved. They are now happily married and have hope for a bright future with their children.
